NOTIFICATION

Whereas the draft of the Karnataka Handlooms and Textiles Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1996 was published as required by clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No.DPAR 57 SRD 95 dated 11th November, 1996 in Part IV - section 2C(i) of the Karnataka Gazette Extraordinary, dated 11th November, 1996 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within thirty days from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

Whereas the said Gazette was made available to the public on 11th day of November, 1996;

And whereas, the objections and suggestions received in this behalf have been considered by the State Government;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990), the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

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1. Title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Handlooms and Textiles Services (Recruitment) Rules, 1996.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Categories of Posts, Number and nature of posts, Scales of Pay, Method of Recruitment and minimum qualifications:- The State Service cadre in respect of the Directorate of Handlooms and Textiles Department Services shall consist of the category of posts and scales of pay specified in column (2) of the schedule below and the number of posts, the method of recruitment and minimum qualifications if any, shall be as specified in the corresponding entries in columns (3), (4), (5) and (6) thereof.

3. Constitution of Service:- The Directorate of Handlooms and Textiles Department Services shall, notwithstanding anything contained in rule 2, in its initial constitution, consist of the categories of posts in the cadre of Group A, B, C, and D, appointed from among persons holding identical posts in the Karnataka Industries and Commerce Department Services immediately before the commencement of these rules on deputation basis:

Provided that no person shall be appointed unless he has expressed, in writing, his willingness to be so appointed, within three months from the date of

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commencement of these rules and if any person has already expressed his willingness before the commencement of these rules, it shall not be necessary for him to express his willingness once again and the decision of the Government on such willingness shall be final.

Provided further that until persons are so appointed, persons holding the posts transferred to the Directorate of Handlooms and Textiles Department Service from the Industries and Commerce Department and Department of Co-operation, Services shall hold the same as on deputation basis.

4. Service for the purpose of leave etc.:- The service rendered in the existing identical posts in the Karnataka Industries and Commerce and Co-operation Department service shall be taken as qualifying service for the purpose of leave, seniority, pay and pension under these rules under the Directorate of Handlooms and Textiles Department.

5. Savings:- Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, action already initiated, if any, for recruitment to any of the categories of posts, in accordance with the Karnataka Industries and Commerce Department Services (Recruitment) Rules, 1964 before the commencement of these rules shall be continued and disposed of under the said rules, as if these rules have not come into force.
