Sub: Amendment to the earlier approved project proposal of M/s Orient Cement Limited at Itagi, Mogla, Diagon Villages, Chittapur Taluk, Kalaburgi District.

Preamble:

The project proposal of M/s. Orient Cement was accorded approval in the 17th SHLCC meeting held on 28.01.2009, to establish "Cement Plant for manufacture of 4 MTPA cement and 3 MTPA Clinker with 50 MW Captive Power Plant" in 1750 acre of land at Itagi, Mogla, Digaon Villages Chittapur Taluk of Kalaburgi District with an investment of Rs.1294.00 crore to provide employment to about 400 persons and accordingly Government Order vide read at (1) above was issued.

As per the request of the company subject was discussed in the 33rd SHLCC meeting held on 19.11.2013 and had accorded approval for extension of time for 2 years was accorded and accordingly Government Order vide read at (2) above was issued.

In the 36th SHLCC meeting held on 15.10.2014 approval was accorded for purchase of 291 acre of additional land for Railway siding and Cement terminal, Water storage, Rain water harvesting, electrical receiving substation provision for KPTCL and township with residential and social amenities and Government Order was issued vide read at (3) above.

In the 45th SHLCC meeting held on 28.09.2016 approval was accorded for extension of time by two years from the date of issue of Government order and accordingly Government Order vide read at (4) above was issued.

As per decision of 53rd SHLCC meeting held on 23.03.2020, Government has accorded approval to grant extension of time to M/s Orient Cement Limited to implement the project approved vide Government Order No. CI 60 SPI 2009, dated 11.08.2009 for further period of two years with a condition that further extension of time will not be considered. Accordingly Government Order vide read at (5) above was issued.

In the 61st SHLCC meeting held on 20.03.2023, Government has accorded approval for the following amendments;

1. To purchase **balance few portions** of lands of 375 acres 13 guntas for compact land under section 109 of KLR Act at Itaga, Mogal & amp; Diggaon Village of Chittapur Taluka of Kalaburagi District.
2. To purchase **additional few portions** of compact lands of 385 Acres 36 guntas land to purchase under section 109 of KLR Act for the lands situated at Itaga, Mogal & amp; Diggaon Village of Chittapur Taluka of Kalaburagi District (for their mining activities and also for further overall infrastructure developments of their Organization) subject to:
 - Non violation of non alienation clauses like PTCL, Inam land, Iluvari land, Govt. land, Nala land, Bandidari land etc. under various Acts and subject to obtaining necessary clearances from Revenue Department/ Concerned authorities.
 - In case of purchase/lease the Government land, the company has to take approval from Revenue Department and concerned authorities.

Accordingly, Government Order vide read at (6) above was issued;

Status of Implementation:

The project has been implemented. Initially, the project was approved for Rs. 1264 crore, the actual investment made as on 31.03.2019 is Rs. 1964.11 crore. Further additional investment of Rs. 2110.24 crore has made as on 31.12.2022 and provided employment to 1425 nos of persons.

Now, the company vide letter dated 10.07.2023 has submitted an amendment request for establishment of 10.1 MW Waste Heat Recovery System (in short WHRS) in the existing plant at Itagi, Village, Chittapur Taluk, Kalaburgi District with an additional investment of Rs.90 crore along with additional employment of 60.

Waste Heat Recovery System:

Large quantities of hot flue gases are generated from the Cement Industry, part of which was not generally utilized commercially for cement manufacturing process. In Cement Plants, hot flue gas coming out of Preheater (PH) downcomer duct, Air Quenching Cooler mid-tap can be recovered to produce significant amount of electricity. Thus, apart from saving energy, there will also be a contribution towards clean and green environment. In this regard a Waste Heat Recovery Boiler System is planned to set-up.

Recommendation of 106th Land Audit Committee Meeting held on 09.08.2023:

The project proponent of the company appeared before the committee and requested approval for the establishment of 10.1 MW - Waste Heat Recovery Boiler (WHRS), additional investment and additional employment as per the terms and conditions stipulated environment clearance of MoEF, GoI.

The committee noted the request of the company and after detailed discussions resolved to recommend to SHLCC for approval for establishment of 10.1 MW - Waste Heat Recovery Boiler (WHRS) in the existing location, additional investment of Rs. 90 crore and additional employment of 60 Nos.

Now, the company vide letter dated 10.08.2023 has requested to accord approval on priority to comply the EC condition of MoEF, GoI.

The Commissioner for Industrial Development and Director of Industries & Commerce vide file read at (7) above has submitted the proposal as per the recommendations of the 106th LAC meeting held on 09.08.2023 for approval.

Accordingly, the file was submitted to competent authority for approval. The competent authority accorded approval in the file concerned.

Hence the following order.

Government is pleased to accord approval for establishment of 10.1 MW - Waste Heat Recovery Boiler (WHRS) in the existing Cement plant located at Itagi, Mogla, Diagon Villages, Chittapur Taluk, Kalaburgi District with an additional investment of Rs. 90 crore, generating additional employment to about 60 persons by the M/s. Orient Cement Limited.

All other terms and conditions indicated in the Government Order read at (1) above, remain unaltered.
