



## **PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA**

**Sub:** Extension of time to the earlier approved project proposal of M/s Venkateshwara Power Projects Limited for “Expansion of Sugar Plant capacity from 5000 TCD to 12000 TCD, Expansion of Co-gen capacity from 23 MW to 59 MW and establishment of 90 KLPD Distillery” at Bedakihal Village, Chikkodi Taluk, Belagavi District.

2. Proceedings of the 132<sup>nd</sup> State Level Single Window Clearance Committee meeting (SLSWCC) held on 16.06.2022.

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### **Preamble:**

State Level Single Window Clearance committee (SLSWCC) in its 111<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 01.08.2018 has approved the project proposal of M/s Venkateshwara Power Projects Limited for “Expansion of Sugar Plant capacity from 5000 TCD to 12000 TCD, Expansion of Co-gen capacity from 23 MW to 59 MW and establishment of 90 KLPD Distillery”, with an investment of Rs.362.33 crore, generating employment to about 389 persons at Bedakihal Village, Chikkodi Taluk, Belagavi District and accordingly, Government Order vide read at (1) above was issued.

Company vide its letter dated 09.02.2022 has stated that, the following effective steps have been taken to implement the project.

1. Company has achieved crushing of 7500 TCD Sugar plant with 23 MW Co-gen, 90 KLPD distillery plant of Ethanol & EMA project.
2. The Company has purchased 60.55 acres of land and converted.
3. Project implementation is delayed due to bank loan and covid-19 crises.
4. Letter of Intent for design, Engineering, Manufacturing, Procurement, Supply including Erection and Commissioning of Co-gen plant has been issued on 16.09.2021.
5. The order has been placed for supply of equipment to various suppliers has been made.
6. Taken steps to obtain NOCs / Clearances from Govt. Departments like KSPCB, KPTCL, KERC etc.

Hence, the company vide its letter dated 29.01.2022 has requested for Extension of time by 2 years to implement the project.

**Recommendation of 95<sup>th</sup> LAC meeting held on 07.06.2022:**

The representative of the company appeared before the Committee through V.C and requested for extension of time by 2 years.

The Committee noted the request of the company and after detailed discussions decided to recommend to SLSWCC for grant of extension of time by 2 years to implement the project, with a condition that further extension of time will not be considered. In the 132<sup>nd</sup> State Level Single Window Clearance Committee (SLSWCC) Meeting held on 16.06.2022 the proposal was examined & approved.

Government has examined the recommendations of the 132<sup>nd</sup> SLSWCC meeting in all aspects.

Hence the following order.
