Notification

No. DPAR/18/SRD/99, Bangalore, Dated: 14th June 2001

Whereas the draft of the Karnataka Industries and Commerce Services (Recruitment) Rules, 2000, was published as required by clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No. DPAR 18 SRD 99, dated 24-6-2001, in Part IV-A of Karnataka Gazette Extraordinary dated 27-6-2000, inviting objections/ suggestions from persons likely to be affected thereby, within thirty days from the date of publication of the draft in the Official Gazette.

Whereas the said Gazette was made available to the public on 27-6-2000.

And whereas, objections and suggestions received have been examined by the State Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990), the Government of Karnataka hereby make the following rules, namely:-

Rules

1. Title and Commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Industries and Commerce Services (Recruitment) Rules, 2001.
- 2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official-Gazette.

Method of recruitment and minimum qualifications- In supersession of all Notifications issued in the schedule, the Karnataka Industries and Commerce Service: s consist n respect of each category of post and scale of pay specified in column (2) of schedule to these rules and the cadre strength, the method of recruitment and the minimum qualifications, if any, shall be as specified in the corresponding entries in columns (e), (4), (6), (7) and (8) thereof.

3. Repeal and Savings.- The Karnataka Industries and Commerce Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1964 are hereby repealed;

Provided that the said repeal shall not affect,-

- a) the previous operation of the said rules of anything duly done or suffered thereund or
- b) affect any right, privilege, liability or obligation acquired, accrued or incurred under t said rules.
